We've also launched a **Gifted and Talented** accelerated program and provide on-site support for students who need extra help.

Our students also benefit from **iPads** in the classroom, as well as interactive **SmartBoards** and computers in every homeroom. In addition to our computer lab with Internet access, we offer WiFi and laptops for student use. Parents have 24/7 online access to their children's grades via Powerschool and daily **teacher blogs** keep parents in the loop on classroom activities





Small Blessings Pre-K3 and Pre-K4

The Small Blessings pre-school programs offer **flexible scheduling** so families can select the program that best meets the developmental needs of each child. Families can enroll three-year-olds for two-, three- or five-day sessions. All pre-K4 students attend school Monday through Friday to ease the transition to kindergarten. Children must be potty trained before enrollment.

Kindergarten

Sacred Heart's kindergarten offers a full-day program of academic coursework including language arts, math, science, social studies, computer skills, religion, art, library, music, world language and physical education. Teachers tailor instruction to the individual abilities of each student, blending learning centers, hands-on activities and play to prepare young learners for first grade.

Flexible Hours for Busy Parents

Sacred Heart offers before-care beginning at 7 a.m. and after-care until 6 p.m. to accommodate working parents.
